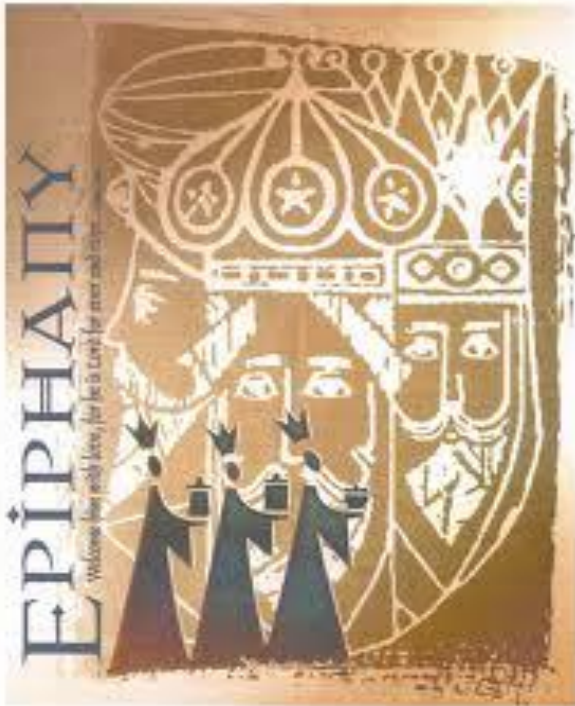

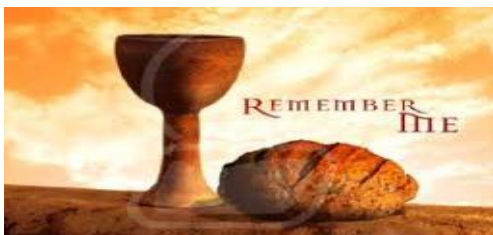
The 2014 Flower Calendar has been posted in the Narthex.
