Beginning September 11, 2011, Reagin Brown will be our Interim Pastor. As we understand from our D.S., Ron Schults, an intentional interim pastor is generally a retired minister with a number of years of experience, has some special training, and is usually assigned for short periods of time. With the special training, the intentional interim pastor is in a position to review our program, to see how we function as a church, and make recommendations for our programs and our membership activities. Hopefully, this will help us become more effective in our work for the Lord and our church growth.

Reagin and his wife Sally have three children Timon is married, has two children, and lives in St. Petersburg, Florida. Amy lives in Detroit, Michigan; and Courtney is married and is a student at University of Alabama in Tuscaloosa.

Bro. Reagin is a 1971 graduate of the University of Alabama with a B.A. degree in History and a 1975 graduate of Drew Theological School, Madison, N.J. with a Master of Divinity.

He began his ministry preaching on the Detroit Circuit in 1973. He served two appointments at Forest Lake in Tuscaloosa, first as an Associate and later as the Senior Pastor. While serving in Reform he was Chairman of The Economic Development Committee for the City of Reform and was named Citizen of the Year in 1985. He also served as Pastor of Ensley 1st UMC, Muscle Shoals 1st UMC, Scottsboro 1st UMC, and Fort Payne 1st UMC. Reagin has also served on many conference boards and is well qualified to lead our congregation.
