Our color today is green, which symbolizes growth in Christ.

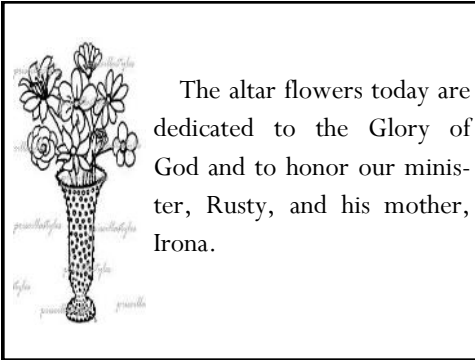
