EASTER celebrates the resurrection of Jesus Christ, thus making it the most important Christian festival of the year. On the third day, Christ's tomb was empty, he arose, and people talked with him. Christians believe his resurrection means that they too will someday receive a new life after death. Easter can fall on any Sunday, with GOOD FRIDAY three days before, between March 22 and April 25, since it is celebrated on the first Sunday after the first full moon in the northern Hemisphere.

The new plant life that comes in the spring is associated with the new life that Christians gain because of the crucifixion and resurrection of Christ. The word Easter may have come from the English word, Eastre. Some believe Eastre was the name of a pagan goddess of spring, a spring festival, or the name of a season.


