A word from James.....

As we walked down Park Avenue recently in New York City, Caroline and I saw a familiar sign. It was posted outside the United Methodist Church. The sign read, "Open Hearts ... Open Minds ... Open Doors." Seeing a man standing in the doorway, I stepped up and introduced myself as a Methodist pastor from Alabama. Next, I asked if we could go inside and possibly use the restroom. His response was a firm "No." As we walked away from the church Caroline and I both agreed that the church sign was misleading. Some would say the sign sent a mixed signal.

I wonder if Cahaba Heights UMC also sends mixed signals. We pride ourselves as being open to people of all ages and walks of life, but are we any different from the congregation in New York? Before answering, consider the fact that the two age groups that we are least effective in reaching are youth and young adults. We currently have a small youth Sunday school class, but no Sunday school class for young adults, married or unmarried. Unfortunately, just hoping one will get started or reminiscing about how it was "in the good old days when 20, 30, 40, 50 or more attended youth and young adult activities" are usually fruitless exercises. Changing a situation involves making a commitment to being "open" to the ones we hope to reach.

In contrast to the experience on Park Avenue, Caroline and I had a wonderful experience at the Cathedral of St. John the Divine. The doors were open and we were welcomed as warmly as longtime members of the congregation. Later, we returned for a tour of the facility and experienced that same warm hospitality from the staff member who led our guided tour. After my experience at the Cathedral and with the misleading sign, it is highly unlikely that I would recommend the church on Park Avenue for persons visiting New York.
